

DRIVER AGREEMENT FORM School Year 2017-18

Thank you for volunteering to drive for a United Faith Christian Academy field trip or sporting event. In doing so you may also be needed as a chaperone and if so, will be responsible for monitoring several children. Please be aware of the following rules for field trips and sporting events:

- 1. No siblings or non-UFCA students are allowed on field trips. Siblings may attend sporting events with the permission of the Athletic Director.
- 2. Lower School students are not allowed to sit in the front seat of any vehicle.
- 3. Vehicles may stop only at the approved destination point (no side stops please).
- 4. All traffic laws must be obeyed (including speed limits). Each child must wear a separate seat belt (no double buckling). Kids eight and under and weighing less than 80 pounds must ride in a car seat or booster. Depending on which comes first, kids can upgrade to a seat belt once they turn eight or top 80 pounds. Car seats must be fastened in a rear seat if your child is under five, weighs less than 40 pounds, and if your car contains passenger-side airbags. You can bypass this requirement if our child's safety seat is airbag-compatible.
- 5. Only Christian or classical music and/or G-rated videos may be played in the vehicle (no talk radio or secular music).
- 6. A Field Trip Parent Permission Form for each child must be in your possession when the child is in your vehicle.
