Medical Information Instructions

Each student must have a signed, current <u>2019-2020 Medical Information and Emergency Release Form</u> on file before the student will be allowed to attend school. Form(s) due no later than <u>August 1, 2019</u>.

<u>Important</u>: All handwritten/typed information on form(s) must match the online information in Sycamore. Please, do the following:

- Go to: <u>ufca.org</u> and click the <u>Sycamore Parent Portal</u> at the bottom of the site to log in to Sycamore. (If you need assistance with your Username and Password, please email the Registrar, <u>kim.eustaquio@ufca.org</u>.)
- Go to following areas under My Family:
 - General
 - Review/correct all Family Information
 - Contacts
 - Review/correct all Emergency and Pick-up contacts along with Relationship and Phones.
 - <u>Important</u>: If needed, continue a longer list of contacts on the back of the handwritten/typed form.
 - Medical
 - Review Physician, Dentist, Hospital and Insurance
- Once you have ensured all handwritten/typed information on form(s) matches the online information in Sycamore, please email the signed 2019-20 Medical Information and Emergency Release Form(s) to kim.eustaquio@ufca.org by August 1, 2019. You may also drop off form(s) Tuesdays Thursdays for the remainder of July between 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and Monday Friday, 7:30 a.m 3:30 p.m. in August.

If your student does <u>not</u> require an Emergency Action Plan or does <u>not</u> require medication <u>during school</u>, you are finished!

- o If your student has Asthma, Diabetes, Seizures and/or Allergies requiring an EpiPen, you must submit an **Emergency Action Plan** obtained from your doctor's office.
- o If you student needs medication administered during the school day or would like permission to self-carry please submit an Authorization to Administer Medications form. - o If you would like to supply over the counter medications (Tylenol, Benadryl, etc.) for your student, please submit an Authorization to Administer Medications form. This form must be signed by a doctor.
